This is a FUN opportunity to do a science project and show it to your family and friends. Students choose their own projects, complete them at home (grown-ups can help), and create a visual display to share. Students can work alone or with a partner. Please have both partners fill out a form and indicate that they will be working together. All students who bring a project will receive a free book about science!

**Deadline to register: Monday, March 11, 2019**

**The Science Club meetings on February 27 (grades 2-5) and March 1 (K-1) will focus on brainstorming/discussing/troubleshooting science projects.**

### Types of projects include:

- **Experiments** (e.g., What kind of paper towel is most absorbent? Which shoes help me jump the farthest? When is the best time of day to ask my parents for candy? etc.)
- **Exhibits or models that give information** (e.g., models or displays of the earth, the heart, an airplane, a ribosome, a tree, a bridge, etc.)
- **Collections of items that you have described and classified** (e.g., leaves, feathers, rocks, seashells, seeds, baryons, insects, automobile parts, etc.)

### Rules for projects:

- Nothing dangerous (if you don't know if it's dangerous, ask an adult like a parent or teacher)
- No live animals
- If your project is messy, you are responsible for cleaning it up.
