Types of projects include:

- **Experiments** (e.g., What kind of paper towel soaks up the most water? Which shoes help me jump the farthest? When is the best time of day to ask my parents for candy? etc.)
- **Exhibits or models that give information** (e.g., models or displays of the earth, the heart, an airplane, a ribosome, a tree, a bridge, etc.)
- **Collections of items that you have described and classified** (e.g., leaves, feathers, rocks, seashells, seeds, baryons, insects, automobile parts, etc.)

Rules for projects:

- Nothing dangerous (if you don't know if it's dangerous, ask a responsible adult).
- No live animals.
- If your project is messy, you are responsible for cleaning it up.
